Purpose was to preach Christ - to the Gentiles

This is why I was chosen to be a teacher and a missionary. I am to teach faith and truth to the people who do not know God. I am not lying but telling the truth. 1 Timothy 2:7 (NLV)

But the Lord said to me, "Go, for I will send you far away to the Gentiles!" Acts 22:21 (NLT)

God's Wisdom is Better Than the World's Wisdom - 1 Corinthians 1:10-16 sel (GW)

I. Unity and mission
